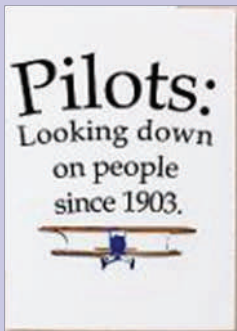

**Whiteman Airport Open House.** Our annual Airport Open House is scheduled for Saturday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. Those that would like to participate by exhibiting their aircraft or hosting a booth for an aviation club or organization should contact my office at (818) 896-5271 to make arrangements. For those that have come out in past years, we hope to see you again this year and for those that have not attended before, we encourage you to come out to say “hi” and meet with fellow pilots and members off our surrounding community!

**American Heroes Air Show at Hansen Dam.** The annual American Heroes Air Show will take place at the Hansen Dam Recreation and Sports Complex on Saturday, November 4<sup>th</sup> from 9 am until 4 pm. Parking and admission are free and we’ll also be there hosting a tent representing the Airport. The event features a diverse collection of helicopters on static display as well as flying demonstrations. Helicopters from local, county, state and federal agencies will be on display plus displays of specialized rescue vehicles and tactics, technical rope rescues and safety demonstrations. Several helicopters will be operating in and around the dam so please keep that in mind for that day as operations in the air will be even busier than normal.

**Vehicle Access Gate Cards.** As a reminder; the new vehicle access gate cards that were issued in 2014 when our new gates were installed require annual renewal, which is scheduled to coincide with the holder’s birthday. Please stop by the office or call us during office hours (Monday through Friday, 8am-5pm) at (818) 896-5271 **before your birthday** to have your card renewed.

**County Hangar Inspections.** We’ve completed our first round of County hangar inspections and thank you to all that came out to help us complete this important process. We are available seven days a week, by appointment, to complete your quick and easy hangar inspection.

### City of Santa Monica and Museum of Flying Sign Long-Term Lease

Long term lease contributes to a sustainable future for a beloved cultural institution and community-gathering place

SANTA MONICA, Calif. – The City of Santa Monica and the Museum of Flying have agreed to a long-term lease for five years with the option to renew for an additional five. The museum has served the community since 1979, sharing Santa Monica’s aviation history as the home of the Douglas Aircraft Company with thousands of visitors and students annually.

“The City of Santa Monica is fully committed to doing its part to preserve and celebrate our rich aviation history,” said Mayor Pro Tem Glean Davis. “We expect the Museum of Flying will serve the community for years to come and will be a center piece as the airport fully transitions to parks, open space, recreation, education and cultural uses.”

Mayor Pro Tem Davis joined Museum of Flying Managing Director Dan Ryan and President and Chairman David G. Price for a brief ceremony for the lease this morning.

In return for a nominal rent fee, the museum commits to continuing free tours for schools and allowing the City to use the facility four times per year for community events at no cost.

“We are thrilled to have the City as a true partner. The lease terms and length will assure our supporters that we have stability and a bright future in Santa Monica,” said Museum of Flying President and Chairman, David G. Price.
