2015 Los Angeles County Air Show. The second annual Los Angeles County Air Show will take place at Fox Field in Lancaster on March 21st and 22nd. This year the United States Air Force Thunderbirds Jet Demonstration Team will be performing! Last year's show was an incredible event with many flying performances and static display aircraft. This year's promises to be even better and I highly recommend checking it out if you didn't make the trip up to WJF last year.
