## Spotlight on: State Water Resources Control Board Emergency Water Conversation Regulations

On July 15, 2014, the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) passed a resolution adopting emergency regulations adding new sections to Title 23 of the California Code of Regulations. The proposed emergency regulations include a prohibition on certain classes of water use, an order for all urban water suppliers to implement mandatory conversation measures, and an order for water suppliers with 3,000 or more service connections to provide monthly data on water production. On July 22, 2014, the County Board of Supervisors unanimously approved the immediate implementation of said statewide emergency water conversation regulations.

The emergency regulations adopted by SWRCB focus on outdoor water use and would prohibit each of the following, except in the case of health or safety needs or to comply with a term or condition in a permit issued by a state or federal agency:

- The direct application of water to hard surfaces such as driveways, sidewalks and parking lots.
- Watering of outdoor landscapes that cause runoff to adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways parking lots or structures.
- Using a hose to wash an automobile, unless the hose is fitted with a shut-off nozzle.
- Using potable water in a fountain or decorative water feature, unless the water is recirculated.

Effectively immediately, the County has requested that we take the necessary steps to fully comply with the SWRCB emergency regulations and to implement the following Best Management Practices related to outdoor usage including:

- Not irrigating landscaped areas with potable water between the hours of 9:00 am and 4:00 pm.
- Eliminating excessive overspray, excessive misting, over pressurization, misalignment or tilted spray heads, or other malfunction and/or out-of adjustment condition which results in unreasonable waste of potable water.
- Permitting the excess use, loss or escape of potable water through breaks, leaks, or other malfunctions in plumbing.

Water conservation efforts being put into place at each of the five (5) Los Angeles County Airports include the following:

- Hoses at all the wash racks will be outfitted with positive shut-down nozzles.
- Watering of landscaped areas will be reduced and limited to early morning or evening hours.

We will also be making regular inspections to ensure that any leaks, breaks or other malfunctions in plumbing are quickly identified and repaired.

We also ask that if you see any leaky plumbing or missing hoses or nozzles to please report it to the Administration Office so that we may fix it in a timely manner.

We appreciate your cooperation in helping us conserve water at our Airports.
